



Financial Assistance Application

The West Ottawa Soccer Club Board of Directors sets aside a specific amount of financial aid to assist families in an effort to allow all children to participate in WOSC programs. The level of funding available will depend primarily on a family's income AND the amount of available funding for the current year.

Please review the eligibility table on page three (3) of this document which provides the financial assistance eligibility requirement.

The WOSC Financial Assistance Program includes a commitment by each family to provide some volunteer assistance to the Club.

The Club requires an initial payment of 20% of the program fee to be submitted with the Financial Assistance Application.

Instructions:

In order to apply to the West Ottawa Soccer Club for financial assistance you must complete the following:

1. Register and pay the minimum 20% for the program. Call the office for assistance with this.
2. Complete the following application form.
3. Provide the Jumpstart Confirmation which is made payable to WOSC within one (1) week of submitting this application.
4. Return the form to the Club Office (1927 Richardson Side Road) along with the other required documentation before the following deadlines:

Indoor OPDL U13 – October 1	Outdoor OPDL – January 15
Indoor Representative – October 1	Outdoor Representative – April 1
Indoor Recreation – October 1	Outdoor Recreation – April 24

5. You will be contacted regarding the amount of assistance that will be available.
6. You will have three (3) days to accept the assistance once offered.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO PLAYER REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE UNTIL THEIR INITIAL PAYMENT AS WELL AS THIS APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED.
