



## West Ottawa Soccer Club Indoor Youth Rec Cup Rules

Jan 28, 2020

The WOSC Indoor League Rules and WOSC Additional Indoor Youth Rec League Rules will be followed except where noted below:

1. All teams will play an equal amount of games.
2. All games will be 2 x 25 minutes, with a 2 minute half-time interval.
3. Call-Up or Call-Across players are eligible to participate in Cup games with one exception...  
**Goalkeepers are NOT allowed to be borrowed from other teams / programs.**

4. If teams are tied after regulation time, a winner shall be decided by FIFA "Kicks from the Penalty Mark" as follows:
  - a. All players are eligible to kick, not just the players who were on the field at the end of game;
  - b. Three players are selected from each team to take the kicks;
  - c. If still tied after three kicks by each team, the kicks shall continue using different players, one for each team, until a winner is decided;
  - d. After 7 kicks (including the goalie), the same players must shoot again. The shooting order stays the same.

**NOTE: Call-Up or Call-Across players are not eligible to participate in the shootout.**

5. Failure to show and forfeited games:
  - a. A team shall be allowed a 5 minute grace period from the scheduled kick-off time. If there are less than 5 players after 5 minutes, the game is awarded to their opponent. The game time clock will start at the scheduled kick-off time, so the 5 minute grace period may be subtracted from the total game time.
  - b. If a team forfeits a game regardless of the reason, its opponent team will be awarded a win with a score of 2-0.

6. All cautions and dismissals will be dealt with under the Discipline By Review or Discipline by Hearing System.

Players found guilty of a red card offence may be ineligible to play in the remainder of the Cup. Verbal/physical assault against a Referee, Team Official and/or player will result in the ejection from the Cup and offenders will be asked to leave the premises at once.

Infractions against Referees will translate into immediate suspension from Cup and will be dealt with in accordance with the OSA Discipline Policies and Procedures.

All incidents will be reported to the EODSA or the participant's District Association.

All Referee decisions are final.

7. For any Cup competitions being decided by Round Robin games, the winner will be determined using the WOSC Teen Rec Outdoor Tournament Tie-Breaking Rules for Round Robin Games.
