Game Rescheduling Policy

Exceptions to this policy may be made by the Program Coordinator due to weather, field conditions or other exceptional circumstances.

Failure to follow these procedures will result in a forfeit being recorded against the offending team(s).

PLEASE NOTE: If there are additional fees associated with the change (ie. rental fees) the requesting team may be asked to cover these costs.

Indoor Youth Policy

Except for facility closures, there will be no rescheduling of Youth Rec League games. Games must be completed by using players borrowed from other teams.

Indoor Adult Policy

Except for facility closures all rescheduling requests must be received 6 days before the original game day.

- 1) A team that wishes to have a game moved must email the Program Coordinator requesting the changes and stating the reason for the request.
- 2) If the Program Coordinator feels the change is possible, the Program Coordinator will email the opposing Team Official(s) to ask if they would be willing to make a change.
- 3) If the change is agreed upon and there is some availability, then the Program Coordinator will send an email out to the Team Officials stating that the change has been approved.
- 4) The Program Coordinator will then update the schedule (or standings if the reschedule is not approved) ensuring the online schedule (or standings) reflects the change.

Outdoor Mini Field Policy

Recreational WOSC league games for the Mini program will not be rescheduled.

Outdoor Full Field Policy

Recreational WOSC league games for the Full Field programs will be rescheduled if the original game is cancelled or abandoned due to inclement weather AND 3/4 of the game has not been played.

If both teams are unable to find a suitable reschedule-date, the game will not be played and will be scored as a 0-0 tie.

Once a game has been cancelled or abandoned:

- 1) The Team Officials must work together to choose a new date for the game.
- 2) Team Officials must choose the day of the week for the game and if possible, provide multiple dates that it can be played.
- 3) Contact the Program Coordinator to reserve a field on the new date.
- 4) The Club will add the game to the schedule and assign a referee.
