

## WOSC Dome Winter Protocols 2021/2022

**NOTE:** *These protocols follow the current COVID-19 guidelines/restrictions suggested by the provincial government, Ontario Soccer, and Ottawa Public Health. Protocols may be updated accordingly.*

### WOSC Domes COVID-19 Protocols

- Physical distancing of 2 metres is required at all times for all users not living in the same household. Note that in accordance with Ontario Soccer Phase 2 guidelines, enhanced training now includes closer group interactions where sharing or competing for the ball activities can now take place, i.e., 1v1, 2v2, 3v3. Therefore incidental contact between players will occur during sessions and games.
- Directional signage to manage traffic flow
- Players/parents must sanitize their hands before entering the field and before exiting the dome. Players are asked to carry their own sanitizer for this step. Sanitizing stations will be available inside each dome
- Each player must complete a COVID-19 Self Assessment Checklist BEFORE every session. Compliance is based on the honour system. [Click here](#) to access the self-assessment.
- WOSC to maintain an up to date Contact Tracing Log for every session. This will be completed by coaches using the PowerUp Connect App except with the adult programs which will be using game sheets.
- Masks or face shields are required by everyone including coaches (unless otherwise exempt) when entering the Dome or WOSC building as per the Temporary Mandatory Mask By-Law. Only players may remove masks during the actual session. All spectators must wear a mask.
- Specific programs (U8 and below, youth house league games) will allow one adult per player into the dome. All other programs will enforce a no spectators rule in the domes.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations are available and frequent hand washing is encouraged.
- The WOSC building is closed to the public except for the emergency use of bathrooms by players.
- Carousels into the domes are NOT to be touched with bare hands. Players will enter through the carousel using their covered forearms, shoulder or back. Only 1 player is allowed in the carousel at a time. The carousel will be sanitized once an hour.
- Drop off/pick up procedures must be followed.
- There will be one washroom available for emergency use only.
